The Museum

Our Group price includes admission to the Brooklands Museum and introductory 1-hour walking tour of the site. We have assumed you will not want to miss the option of a 35-minute tour of Concorde and have this included this. This option comprises.

- Pre-flight briefing under Concorde
- Short film on the restoration project
- Sit in real Concorde passenger seats
- Take-off for your virtual Concorde flight
- Complimentary Concorde flight certificate

Should you **NOT** wish to partake in this option please let me know. The London Bus Museum is also on site and entry is free. We are advised to allow 3 to 4 hours for the full visit. The museum closes at 4pm.

Refreshments

The cafe on site sells drinks, sandwiches and snacks. They are offering a special (pre bookable) lunch package at £11.00 per person (inc. VAT), which includes jacket potatoes served with a garnish of lettuce and tomato. Fillings will be available directly at the Café, based on daily availability. These are also bookable Café Vouchers for Tea & Cake at £5.50. Please let me know if you wish to book these.

Access

Brooklands Museum is a large open-air museum with period buildings and exhibits. there are areas which have bumpy and uneven surfaces. There is no step-free access to board the aircraft, which all have steep boarding steps. If anyone has concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Transport

Transport is by our own cars. and we ask that you please arrange sharing amongst yourselves. The museum has a large free car park. The address is Brooklands Museum, Brooklands Drive, Weybridge, Surrey. **Satnav for visitor car park: KT13 0SL**

Journey planners tell us the travel times are around 1¾ hours but please allow for the rush hour and plan to arrive by 09.45 for our introductory tour planned for 10.00.

Please use the Main Entrance via Mercedes-Benz World. Follow the brown signs to the visitor entrance via Mercedes-Benz World; there is free car park. Please meet at the shop and collect any refreshment vouchers, Concorde Tickets and Museum maps.
